**GRANT AGREEMENT
(Externally Financed)**

GRANT AGREEMENT dated 7 October 2021 between DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA ("Recipient") and ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK ("ADB").

WHEREAS

(A) by a loan agreement dated 26 October 2018 between the Recipient and ADB ("Original Loan Agreement"), ADB provided the Recipient a concessional loan from ADB's ordinary capital resources in the amount of thirty-seven million five hundred thousand Dollars (\$37,500,000) for the purposes of the project described in Schedule 1 to the Original Loan Agreement ("Original Project");

(B) by a grant agreement dated 26 October 2018 between the Recipient and ADB ("Original Grant Agreement"), ADB provided the Recipient a grant from ADB's Special Funds resources in the amount of twelve million five hundred thousand Dollars (\$12,500,000) for the purposes of the Original Project;

(C) by a loan agreement of even date herewith between the Recipient and ADB ("ADB Loan Agreement"), ADB has agreed to make a loan to the Recipient from ADB's ordinary capital resources in the amount of one hundred ten million Dollars (\$110,000,000) ("ADB Loan") for the purposes of the Project, as described in Schedule 1 to the ADB Loan Agreement;

(D) the Recipient has applied to the Government of Japan for a grant, to be administered by ADB, for the purpose of scaling up the Original Project, as described in Schedule 1 to this Grant Agreement ("Project");

(E) the Government of Japan, through the Japan Fund for Poverty Reduction ("JFPR"), has agreed to provide, and ADB has agreed to administer, the grant provided for herein upon the terms and conditions set out in the Arrangement Letter dated 7 October 2009 between ADB and the Government of Japan ("Arrangement Letter"); and

(F) ADB has agreed to make the proceeds of the grant from JFPR available to the Recipient upon the terms and conditions set forth herein;

NOW THEREFORE the parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Grant Regulations; Definitions

Section 1.01. All provisions of ADB's Externally Financed Grant Regulations, dated 1 January 2017 ("Grant Regulations"), are hereby made applicable to this Grant Agreement with the same force and effect as if they were fully set forth herein.

Section 1.02. Wherever used in this Grant Agreement, the several terms defined in the Grant Regulations and the ADB Loan Agreement have the respective meanings therein set forth unless modified herein or the context otherwise requires.

ARTICLE II

The Grant

Section 2.01. ADB agrees to make available to the Recipient a grant from JFPR in the amount of three million Dollars (\$3,000,000) ("Grant").

ARTICLE III

Use of Proceeds of the Grant

Section 3.01. The Recipient shall cause the proceeds of the Grant to be applied to the financing of expenditures on the Project in accordance with the provisions of this Grant Agreement.

Section 3.02. The proceeds of the Grant shall be allocated and withdrawn in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 2 to this Grant Agreement, as such Schedule may be amended from time to time by agreement between the Recipient and ADB.

Section 3.03. Except as ADB may otherwise agree, the Recipient shall procure, or cause to be procured, the items of expenditure to be financed out of the proceeds of the Grant in accordance with the provisions of Schedule 4 to the ADB Loan Agreement.

Section 3.04. Withdrawals from the Grant Account in respect of Goods, Works and Services shall be made only on account of expenditures relating to:

- (a) Goods which are produced in and supplied from and Works and Services which are supplied from such member countries of ADB as shall have been specified by ADB from time to time as eligible sources for procurement; and

- (b) Goods, Works and Services which meet such other eligibility requirements as shall have been specified by ADB from time to time.

Section 3.05. The Grant Closing Date for the purposes of Section 8.02 of the Grant Regulations shall be 31 May 2026 or such other date as may from time to time be agreed between the Recipient and ADB.

ARTICLE IV

Particular Covenants

Section 4.01. In the carrying out of the Project and operation of the Project facilities, the Recipient shall perform, or cause to be performed, all obligations set forth in Schedule 4 to the ADB Loan Agreement and Schedule 3 to this Grant Agreement.

Section 4.02. (a) The Recipient shall (i) maintain separate accounts and records for the Project; (ii) prepare annual financial statements for the Project in accordance with financial reporting standards acceptable to ADB; (iii) have such financial statements audited annually by independent auditors whose qualifications, experience and terms of reference are acceptable to ADB, in accordance with auditing standards acceptable to ADB; (iv) as part of each such audit, have the auditors prepare a report, which includes the auditors' opinion(s) on the financial statements and the use of the Grant proceeds, and a management letter (which sets out the deficiencies in the internal control of the Project that were identified in the course of the audit, if any); and (v) furnish to ADB, no later than 6 months after the end of each related fiscal year, copies of such audited financial statements, audit report and management letter, all in the English language, and such other information concerning these documents and the audit thereof as ADB shall from time to time reasonably request.

(b) ADB shall disclose the annual audited financial statements for the Project and the opinion of the auditors on the financial statements within 14 days of the date of ADB's confirmation of their acceptability by posting them on ADB's website.

(c) The Recipient shall enable ADB, upon ADB's request, to discuss the financial statements for the Project and the Recipient's financial affairs where they relate to the Project with the auditors appointed pursuant to subsection (a)(iii) hereinabove, and shall authorize and require any representative of such auditors to participate in any such discussions requested by ADB. This is provided that such discussions shall be conducted only in the presence of an authorized officer of the Recipient, unless the Recipient shall otherwise agree.

Section 4.03. The Recipient shall enable ADB's representatives to inspect the Project, the Goods, Works and Services, and any relevant records and documents.

Section 4.04. The Recipient acknowledges and agrees that this Grant Agreement is entered into by ADB, not in its individual capacity, but as grant administrator for JFPR. Accordingly, the Recipient agrees that (a) it may only withdraw Grant proceeds to the extent that ADB has received proceeds for the Grant from JFPR and such proceeds has not been suspended or cancelled in whole or in part by JFPR, and (b) that ADB does not assume

any obligations or responsibilities of JFPR in respect of the Project or the Grant other than those set out in this Grant Agreement.

ARTICLE V

Effectiveness

Section 5.01. The following is specified as an additional condition to the effectiveness of this Grant Agreement for the purposes of Section 9.01(e) of the Grant Regulations: the ADB Loan Agreement shall have been duly executed and delivered, and shall have become legally binding upon the Recipient, in accordance with its terms, subject only to the effectiveness of this Grant Agreement.

Section 5.02. A date 90 days after the date of this Grant Agreement is specified for the effectiveness of this Grant Agreement for the purposes of Section 9.04 of the Grant Regulations.

ARTICLE VI

Termination

Section 6.01. This Grant Agreement and all obligations of the parties hereunder shall terminate on the date on which the ADB Loan Agreement and all obligations of the parties thereunder terminate.

ARTICLE VII

Miscellaneous

Section 7.01. Each of the Secretary of the Ministry of Finance, Deputy Secretary to the Treasury, and Director General of the Department of External Resources of the Recipient is designated as representative of the Recipient for the purposes of Section 11.02 of the Grant Regulations.

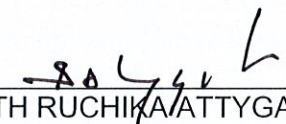

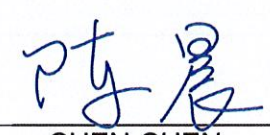

SCHEDULE 1

Description of the Project

1. The objective of the Project is to improve efficiency, equity, and responsiveness of the PHC system of the Recipient.
2. The Project will further augment the Original Project and shall comprise the following: enhancing the efficiency of the pre-hospital ambulance system (1990 Suwa Seriya Ambulance system) to link COVID-19 patients to the designated hospitals for further treatment and management without compromising the non-COVID-19 emergency services.
3. The Project is expected to be completed by 30 November 2025.

SCHEDULE 2

Allocation and Withdrawal of Grant Proceeds

General

1. The table attached to this Schedule sets forth the Categories of items of expenditure to be financed out of the proceeds of the Grant and the allocation of the Grant proceeds to each such Category ("Table"). (Reference to "Category" in this Schedule is to a Category of the Table.)

Basis for Withdrawal from the Grant Account

2. Except as ADB may otherwise agree, the proceeds of the Grant shall be allocated to items of expenditure, and disbursed on the basis of the withdrawal percentage for each item of expenditure, as set forth in the Table.

Reallocation

3. Notwithstanding the allocation of Grant proceeds and the withdrawal percentages set forth in the Table,

- (a) if the amount of the Grant allocated to any Category appears to be insufficient to finance all agreed expenditures in that Category, ADB may, in consultation with the Recipient, (i) reallocate to such Category, to the extent required to meet the estimated shortfall, amounts of the Grant which have been allocated to another Category but, in the opinion of ADB, are not needed to meet other expenditures, and (ii) if such reallocation cannot fully meet the estimated shortfall, reduce the withdrawal percentage applicable to such expenditures in order that further withdrawals under such Category may continue until all expenditures thereunder shall have been made; and
- (b) if the amount of the Grant allocated to any Category appears to exceed all agreed expenditures in that Category, ADB may, in consultation with the Recipient, reallocate such excess amount to any other Category.

Disbursement Procedures

4. Except as ADB may otherwise agree, the Grant proceeds shall be disbursed in accordance with the Loan Disbursement Handbook.
